JOB DESCRIPTION

1.0 PURPOSE OR MAIN FUNCTION OF THIS POSITION:

- 1.1 Under the direction of an Officer, the Firefighter is responsible for assisting with:
- a) Extinguishing and preventing fires.
 - b) Providing emergency medical care in a pre-hospital setting within the level of training.
 - c) Providing manpower for Rescues, Hazardous Situations and Hazardous Material Incidents.
 - d) Performing all duties in accordance with standing orders, standard operating guidelines and other department regulations.

2.0 MAJOR DUTIES:

- 2.1 PERFORMS FIRE FIGHTING DUTIES BY:
- a) Responding to fire emergencies.
 - b) Driving vehicles with discretion, including personal vehicles, during an emergency.
 - c) Applying proper Fire fighting techniques needed to control and/or extinguish fires.
 - d) STAYING AWAY from any Fire Department operations while under the influence of alcohol and/or prescription drugs which may cause impairment.
 - e) Cleaning up and returning equipment to service after an emergency.
 - f) Maintaining personal protective equipment and other equipment issued in good condition.
 - g) Attending a minimum of 70% of all regularly scheduled training sessions and attending special schools and other training opportunities.
 - h) If requested, assist with the investigation to determine the cause of fires causing loss of life or property.
 - j) Following orders and co-operating with Police and Emergency Medical Services.
 - k) Refraining from giving out information to the news media, or other persons, about emergencies without authorization from the Fire Chief.

3.0 FURTHER DETAILS OF JOB:

- 3.1 Ability to deal with the public in a polite, sympathetic and efficient manner, regardless of how frustrating or unnerving the situation may be.
- 3.2 Ability to cooperate with other Emergency Departments and not degrade or criticize their operation.

- 3.3 Able to cope with a high level of stress and perform all duties efficiently in an emergency situation.
- 3.4 Ability to speak in a clear, articulate manner.
- 3.5 Ability to obtain and maintain a New Hampshire Commercial Driver's License (CDL-B) with air brake and tank endorsement.
- 3.6 Ability to obtain and maintain a valid CPR/AED for Healthcare Provider Certificate.
- 3.7 Ability to be physically agile and capable of physical exertion including lifting heavy objects.

4.0 Recommendation & Input Into Department Operations

- 4.1 May make recommendations to his/her Company Officer regarding operational procedures and equipment maintenance.

5.0 Directives, Manuals, Regulations

- 5.1 Will use and follow Fire Department Policies, Standard Operating Guidelines, By-Laws and written memos.
- 5.2 During emergencies or training will follow all orders of Department Officers.
- 5.3 Other specific tasks within the job description may be given by written memo or verbally.
- 5.4 Assume other responsibilities as may be assigned.
